Instead of fighting the original architecture, Kemble sunk a huge custom tufted headboard right against the wall to turn the existing bookshelves into a snug nook. "I wanted it to match the bed frame but not take up as much depth as the shelves, so you still feel cocooned lying down," Maddock says. "The room has such character since the bed is surrounded by books," she adds. Kemble covered the shelves, which were painted ivory and lacked detail, in a tobacco-colored grass cloth to amplify the library-esque warmth. Most important for Maddock was her mother's antique rug, which she emphasized by "floating" the bed on Lucite cubes.
